Vacuum Seal Your Food in 6 Simple Steps



HOW TO USE

1. **Place food** into a Seal It vacuum bag.
2. **Seal the zipper** using the clip or your fingers.
3. **Smooth the valve area** flat and free of wrinkles.
4. **Align the Turbo Seal Pro** over the valve.
5. **Press the button** to remove air from the bag.
6. **Gently press the valve** after sealing to complete the seal.

TROUBLESHOOTING

There's still air in the bag:

- Make sure the ziplock is fully closed.
- Ensure no food particles, moisture, or oil are in the seal.
- Check that the valve is clean, dry, and pushed down.
- Liquids must be frozen before sealing to avoid damage.

Nozzle is cracked:

- Reach out to support for a replacement.

Device won't turn on:

- Charge the device fully using the included **Micro USB** cable.
- Try a different Micro USB cable if needed.
- Only use the device when unplugged.

SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Do not seal hot foods or non-frozen liquids.
- Never microwave Seal It bags.
- Keep the device dry; never submerge in water.
- Let the unit cool between extended uses.
- Use only with Seal It bags for best performance.
- Keep away from children.
- Do not operate while charging.

To avoid food safety issues:

- Always wash bags with warm, soapy water after use.
- Properly clean bags that held raw meat or seafood.
- Do not reuse damaged bags.
- Avoid cross-contamination between raw and cooked food.
- Follow standard food safety and storage practices.

DO'S & DON'TS

Do:

- Always seal the ziplock completely before vacuuming
- Keep the valve area clean, flat, and free from oil or moisture
- Freeze liquids before sealing to prevent leaks or damage
- Use warm soapy water to clean bags after every use
- Use the included Micro USB cable or a good-quality one
- Let the device cool between sealing sessions
- Gently press the valve after sealing to lock in freshness

Don't:

- Don't leave food, oil, or moisture in the zip seal area
- Don't use the sealer while it's plugged in
- Don't force or over-press the nozzle — it can crack
- Don't try to seal unsealed liquids — always freeze first
- Don't submerge the device or get the charging port wet
- Don't reuse bags without properly washing them
- Don't microwave vacuum-sealed bags
- Don't ignore signs of wear — contact support early
